

**PHOTO PERMISSION**

There will be occasions when our setting may wish to take photographs or make video recordings of the children. Sometimes this is for educational purposes but on others it may be for publicity.

Similarly there may be occasions when the local press visit to record particular events and they may wish to publish photographs of the children in newspapers or other publications

In order to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998, the setting needs your consent before taking photographs of your child or making video recordings. Therefore we would appreciate you answering the following questions before signing, dating and returning the form
